Health and Safety

New P1 Entrants September 2020 - Distribution of Starting School Pack

Normally during the month of June we hold an Induction morning for the new Primary One children and an information session for parents. Regretfully, this will not be possible this year due to the impact of Covid-19. I understand that this may be an anxious time for you and your child but we will do everything we can to make your child's transition to school as smooth as possible. If circumstances allow, we hope to organise small group induction sessions for the new P1 entrants in August. We will keep all parents updated about this over the Summer. We would ask that parents of new Primary 1 children come to the main front door of the school on **Tuesday 23rd June between 10am- 3pm** to receive your child's Starting School Pack.

It is important you pick up this pack and complete the necessary forms and return to school by Friday 26th June.

When you arrive in school make your way to the **front door** of the school building (**Parents of new P1 Entrants only**) and allow at least 2 metres between each person. Press the buzzer at the front door. We would ask that you do not enter the school building unless prompted to do so. A member of staff will give you your child's Starting School Pack at the front door.
