<u>Relax Kids</u>

Primary 5-7 children will have their final Relax Kids session on 8th April 2022. In the Relax Kids classes, the children explored different emotions that they may experience in school or out of school such as stress, anxiety, worry and happiness. The children have learned and discussed the benefit of different strategies that they can use to cope and manage these different emotions. These include; exercise, stretching, meditation, breathing techniques and positive self-talk. The children have thoroughly enjoyed the Relax Kids programme and it has been a great success.

Creative Music After-School

Funding has been secured through the Extended Schools Programme for a Creative Music After-School. Primary 3 children (Group 2) will have their final two sessions on 6th April and 27th April.

Primary 4 will then have the opportunity to attend this After-School, commencing <u>Wednesday 4th May 2022 – Wednesday 29th June 2022.</u> The Creative Music After-School will be facilitated by a trained Music Specialist, Mr Donal Gormley, and will be offered to P4 pupils from 2.45 pm until 3.45 pm.

Music has numerous benefits for children including; activating both sides of the brain, improving listening, concentration and problem-solving, improving working memory, confidence building, promoting creativity and self-expression and promoting well-being - reducing anxiety and stress.

St. Mary's has invested in the expensive Wordshark programme for all Primary 2 and Primary 3 children, to help bridge the gaps in learning, due to school closures during Lockdown. "Wordshark" provides a fun and effective games-based solution for pupils learning to spell and read. It includes everything that pupils need in order to achieve their spelling targets. The children have received their usernames and password details for the spelling programme which will reinforce the spellings the children are learning in school. It is vital that your child uses this resource to consolidate and reinforce their spellings.

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Accelerated Reader

As you are aware, your child was set an individual AR (Accelerated Reader) target in January. The targets that are set for each child depend on two factors, the result of a Star Reading Test that each child sits at the start of the term and the teacher's estimation of the amount of time the child is likely to read each day.

After the Star Reading Test is taken, the children are awarded particular levels for their reading books. This is called their ZPD. The Accelerated Reading Program has determined that the child should read and take quizzes within these levels. It is so important that your child uses this fantastic resource for reading, to improve fluency and comprehension skills. The end date for this term's target is <u>8th April 2022</u>.

Please encourage your child to keep reading and taking AR quizzes to ensure he/she reaches 100% by 8th April 2022. Prizes will be awarded to those children who reach their target.

As parents, you can ensure that your child gets the most out of the program by reading regularly and consistently and asking the children questions about the book they are reading. Make sure to ask your child about the scores they are achieving in the quizzes.
